

**THE 3<sup>RD</sup> PROJECT MEETING HAS BEEN HELD IN OCTOBER 2017**

In the period between 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> of October 2017, the B.Living partnership held its third meeting in Bristol - UK.

In the two days meeting, the main focus had been placed upon revising and finalizing the curriculums' structure which will be used as a basis for the development of the contents of training material and tools (Handbook & Toolbox).



Taking into consideration the results of the research studies carried out in the partner countries, the partnership have assessed and identified the specific needs for trainers & teachers in the field of intercultural & interreligious training.

**THE CURRICULUM**

Based on the research study results, the B.LIVING partnership approved the final version of the training curriculum.

Six Learning Units (LU) are proposed:

- LU1. Values and beliefs
- LU2. Self and identity
- LU3. Community
- LU4. Interculturality
- LU5. Interreligious learning environment
- LU6. Conflict management

...will be developed to provide in depth information about basic concepts, definitions and innovative methodological approaches for handling religious diversity in positive and dialogical ways in the classroom settings and in non-formal and informal learning environments.

Completing this Handbook, will help users to know more about different intercultural & interreligious issues, which can help them improve their training skills and offer.
